Yale Wins at the Traps.

BOSTON, May 9.-Vale won the intercollegiate match trap shooting contest for the fifth time at the Boston Athletic Association traps in Riverside to-day by defeating Princeton, Harvard, and the University of Pennsylvania teams by a comfortable margin. The Yale freshmen also added to Yale's triumph by defeating the Harvard freshmen earlier in the day in a fifty-bird match shoot by the close score of 162 to 161.

The intercollegiate match was for 100 birds, Sargent and expert traps being used indiscriminately throughout the match, giving a wide variance to the shooting.

The final scores were: Yale, 415; Princeton, 373; Harvard, 371; University of Pennsylvanla, 365.
