YALE CAPTURES SHOOT.

Wins Intercollegiate Trapshooting Title for Eleventh Time.

Yale trapshooters again demonstrated that the sons of Old Eli are supreme at target busting yesterday when they won the intercollegiate championship for the eleventh consecutive time. The shoot, which is the one big college trapshooting event of the year, was held over the traps of the Perry Circle Gun Club at Chappaqua, N. Y. Three teams representing Yale, Harvard and Pennsylvania competed for the intercollegiate trophy. Ralph Spotts Jr., a Dartmouth man, also shot the program and competed for the individual championship.
